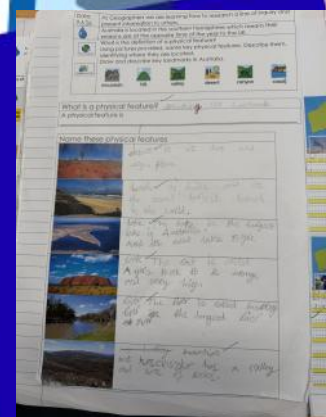
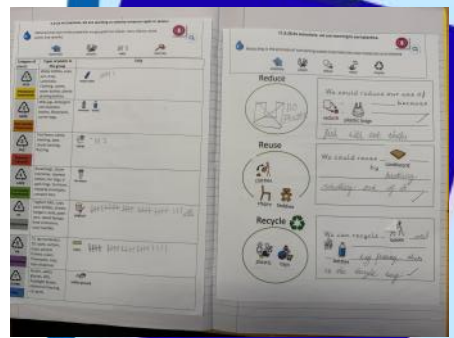


## A+ JELLYFISH NEWS

We've had a busy and exciting week full of learning, laughter, and a little bit of mischief (thanks to some cheeky Cornish pixies!).

In Maths, we've been learning to tell the time using both analogue and digital clocks. The children are slowly becoming experts at spotting "quarter past" and "half past". We are now looking at telling the time to the hour – a great skill to practise at home together! Our writing has taken a magical turn this week and focused on a Cornish tale. The children have been writing about Cornish pixies and have enjoyed imagining the mischief these tiny tricksters might get up to. This week in science, the children have been exploring different types of plastic and thinking carefully about the impact plastic has on our environment. They investigated how plastics are used in everyday life and discussed the difference between reducing, reusing and recycling. The class came up with thoughtful ideas about how we can all make small changes, such as choosing reusable bottles, repurposing packaging and sorting our recycling properly, to help protect our planet. It's been brilliant to see their enthusiasm for becoming more ecofriendly. In Geography, we've been comparing our local climate to the different climate zones in Australia. From tropical rainforests to arid deserts, the children were amazed by how diverse the weather can be across the country. Finally with Sports Day just around the corner, we've been practising our races and refining our teamwork. The children are enthusiastic and showing great sportsmanship.

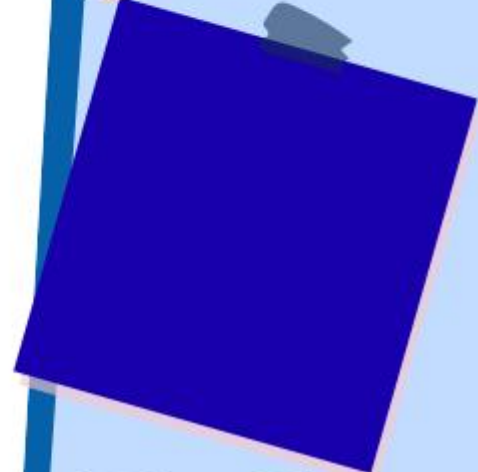
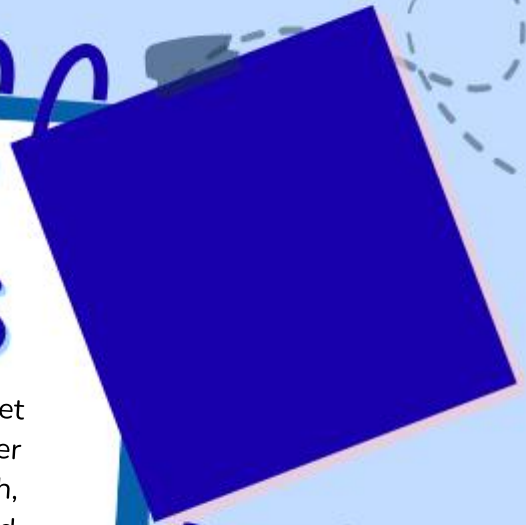


# SWORDFISH



## A+ SWORDFISH NEWS

This week Year 4 and 5 had the pleasure of taking part in Rocket Day, led by former RAF engineer and LEGO League leader George Slater. It was an incredible day from start to finish, learning about how physics and maths relate to engineering and technology. The act of loading a plane is actually a huge mathematical challenge and George showed us how his former job used to involve the four operations we use in maths every day. The children took time to design and create their rockets, using several constant variables, and then we had our first round of tests before lunchtime. Some of our children's rockets flew really far and some didn't. We took the afternoon to assess our successes and failures, iterate and redesign the rockets, and then before the end of the day we did a second round of tests. This time, everyone's rockets flew further and faster than before because we had taken the time to fix our mistakes and streamline our design process – just like NASA do with their rockets! A huge thanks for George for his time and efforts all day, and to our two classes for all their hard work. What an amazing day!

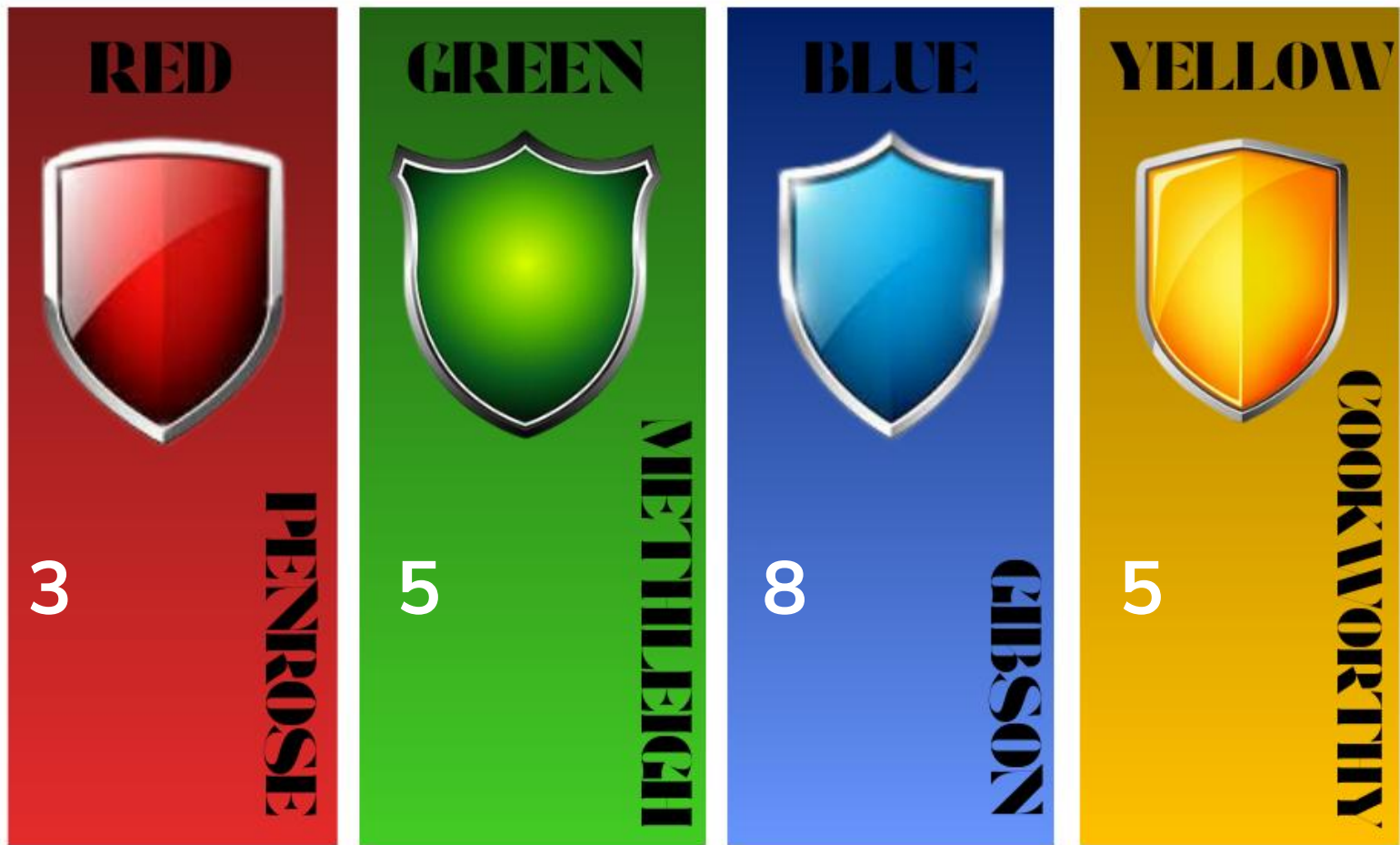


## As a reminder to parents about attendance
