

(ALSO KNOWN AS Short Term Family Accommodation)

There is 1x 4 bed on the top patch and 1x 3 bed on the bottom patch area. These are fully equipped and fully furnished. The prime purpose is to provide convenient and affordable accommodation to single parents in the Services who have contact rights to their children. They also are available for use by other single and married service personnel for visiting family, R&R etc, when not booked by those with contact rights. MoD civilians may also use the house. #### Information

A high-quality information service, both face-to-face and across several digital platforms with provision of information and guidance on relocation; bespoke information for deployment, including the Deployment - Families Information Pack; managing updates onto the Royal Navy Website, RN Forum and Official Facebook Page/Platforms, including those for Naval Service Units.

#### Community

A wide range of community initiatives including regular activity programmes close to Naval Service establishments; bespoke events, including the critical area of Deployment Support; recruitment and training of volunteers; youth work, including the tri-Service Youth Forum; partnership work with external stakeholders.

#### Casework

A specialist and professional casework service offering confidential advice, support and counsel to all wherever they are in the Chain of Command or family unit; an out of hours emergency service 365 days of the year; allocation of Visiting Officers for all casualties listed seriously ill (SI) and above; undertaking compassionate investigations, assessments and recommendations; liaison and partnership with key stakeholders to ensure the best possible outcome for our people.

The RNAS Culdrose casework team have offices in the Medical Centre, the Community Centre, and the Princess Royal Building. Drop-in sessions for advice and guidance will become available soon (details to follow).




